Gardens at TLP. \$500 donation is available for purchase of plants next year. Look at order bare root from Hauser's in Bayfield. M & M green house could be another possible source. New plantings would then need to be watered regularly by volunteers.

Discussed a need for a sign by trail entrance from the parking lot. Bring ideas to next meeting.

Paint is peeling on trim around door of building- needs touch up painting done.

Kay & Terry volunteered to stain the kiosk with available donated stain. Will be completed soon.

Tennis court at Town Park is in ongoing research into resurfacing. Wind screen are not all attached and some attention to putting grommets in &/or looking at the existing screen in storage.

Pat has found information on a heater on a timer for \$373 and would need to be installed by an electrician.

Bike rack in front of warming house would make more sense to be in a different location. We need to find out if it can be removed from present location.

Maple tree on playground is dying and should be removed, suggested to plant 3 new maple trees.

Updates on ice skates. Kay dropped off 29 pairs at Ace hardware for sharpening during the summer.
